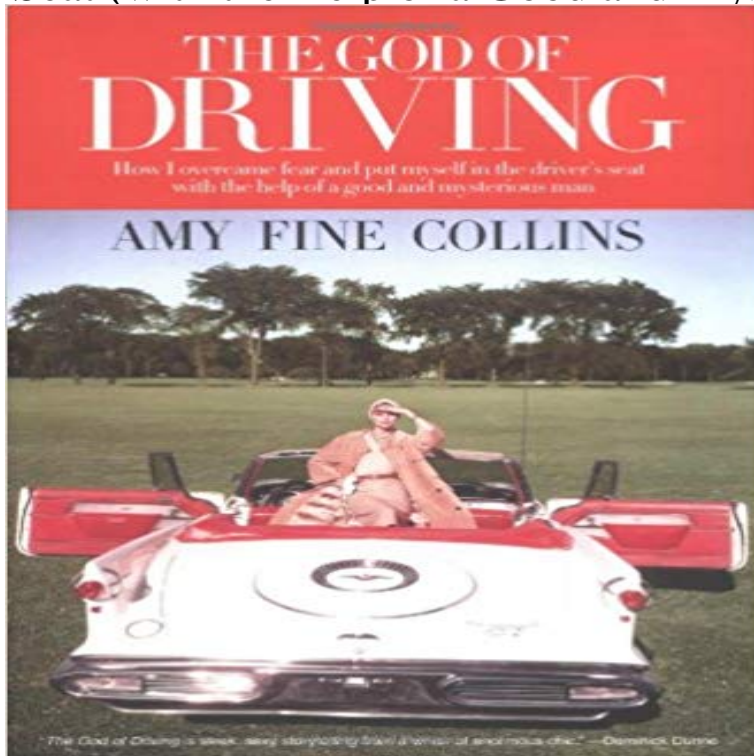


The God of Driving: How I Overcame Fear and Put Myself in the Drivers Seat (with the Help of a Good and Mysterious Man)
