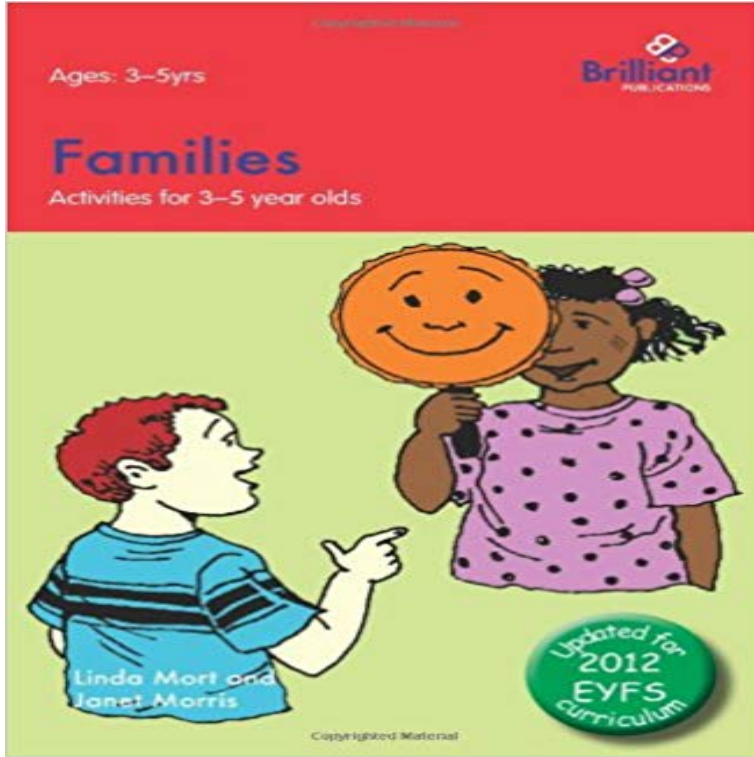


Families: Activities for 3-5 Year Olds - 2nd Edition
