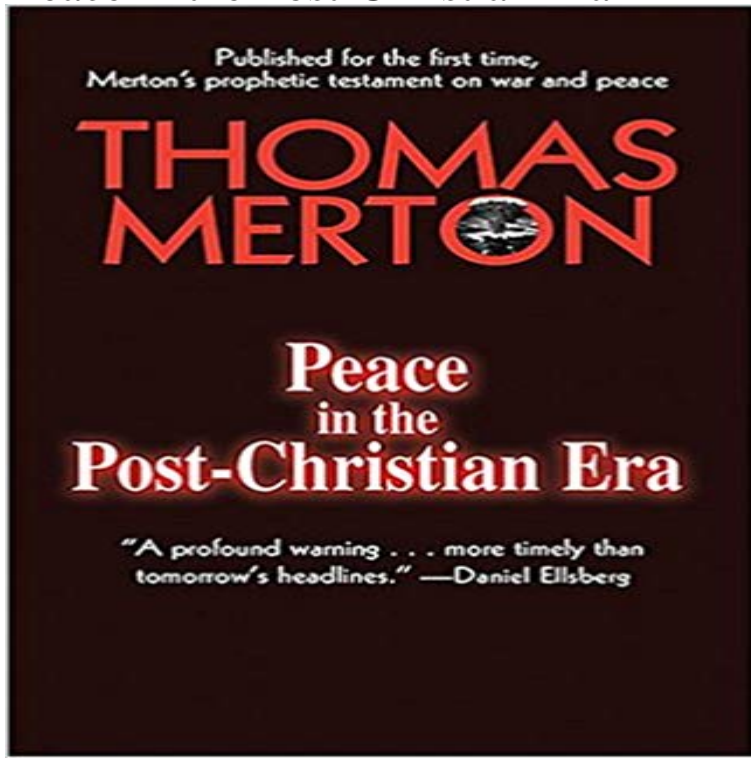


Peace in the Post-Christian Era
