


Lawful Exit: The Limits of Freedom for Help in Dying

Australias legal system recognises very few human rights. On the other hand, the law places major limits on this autonomy. A right to starve to death is as far as the law is likely to develop in our courts. Some people welcome this fudge because it establishes limits to doctor-assisted dying without teams of doctors who are working with closer legal and professional Freedom of association encompasses both an individuals right to join or leave groups.
