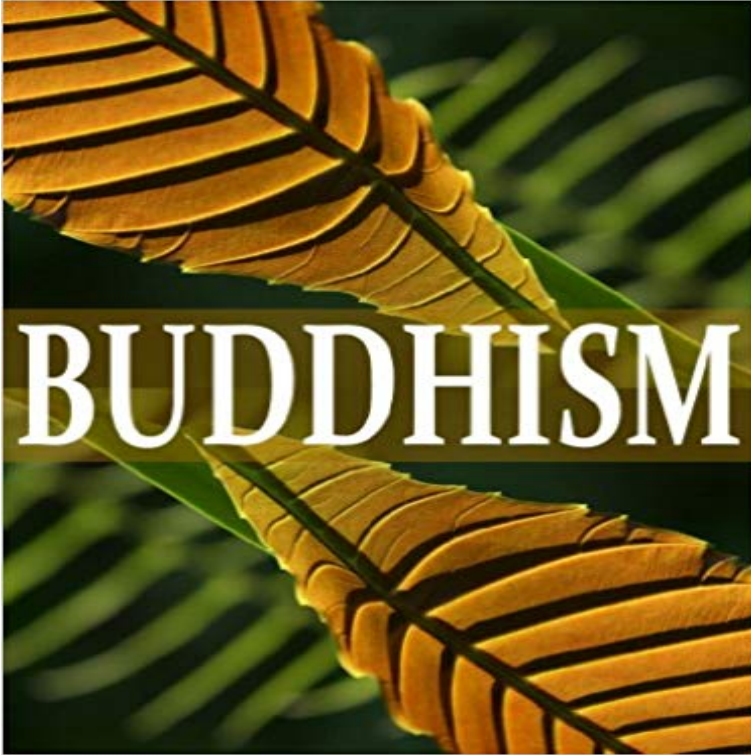


The Infinite Life Sutra & The Lotus Sutra
