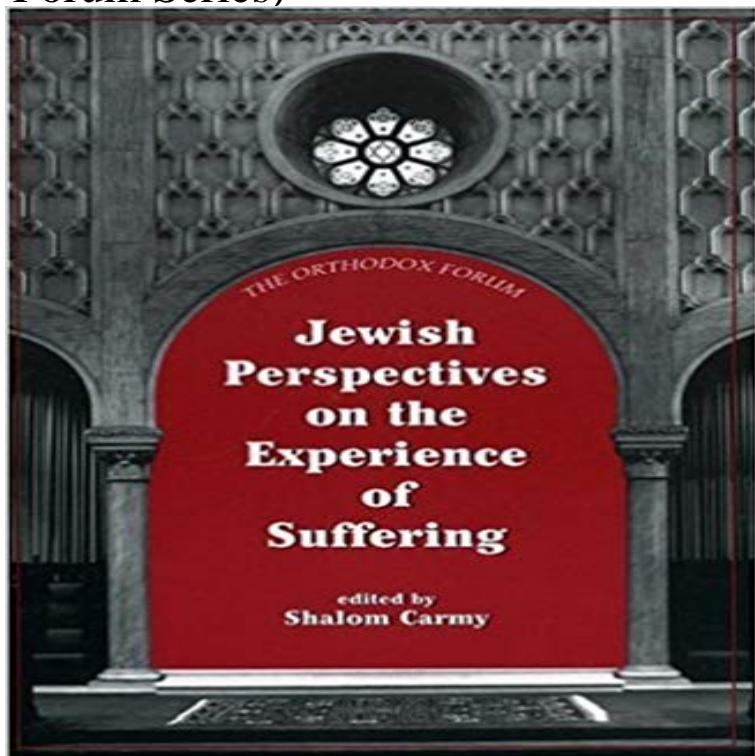


# Jewish Perspectives on the Experience of Suffering (The Orthodox Forum Series)
