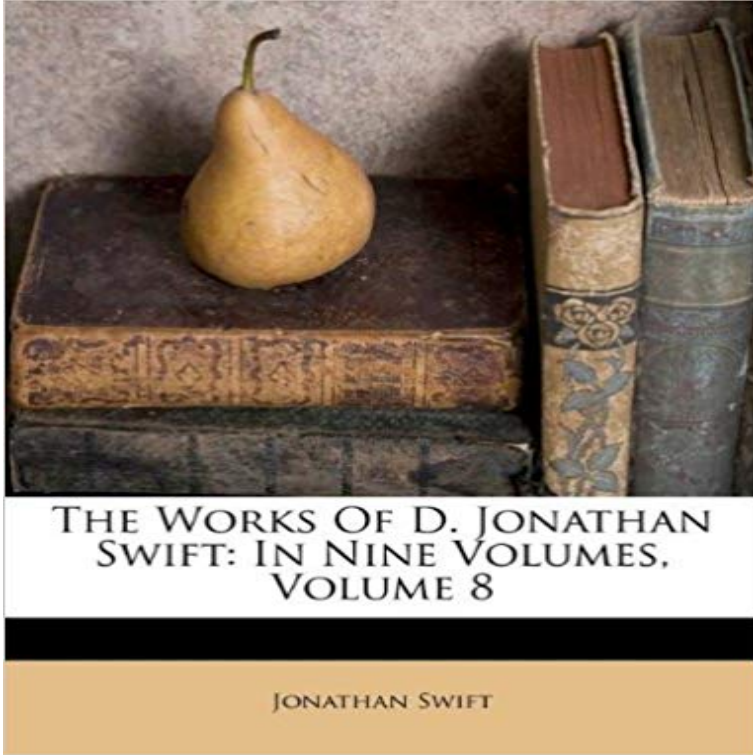


# The Works Of D. Jonathan Swift: In Nine Volumes, Volume 8
