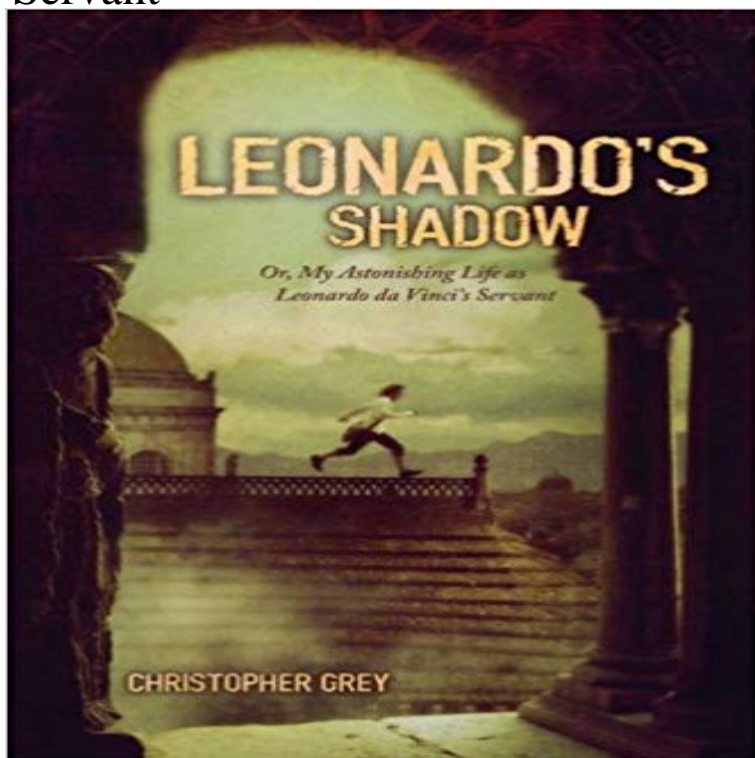


# Leonardos Shadow: Or, My Astonishing Life as Leonardo da Vincis Servant
