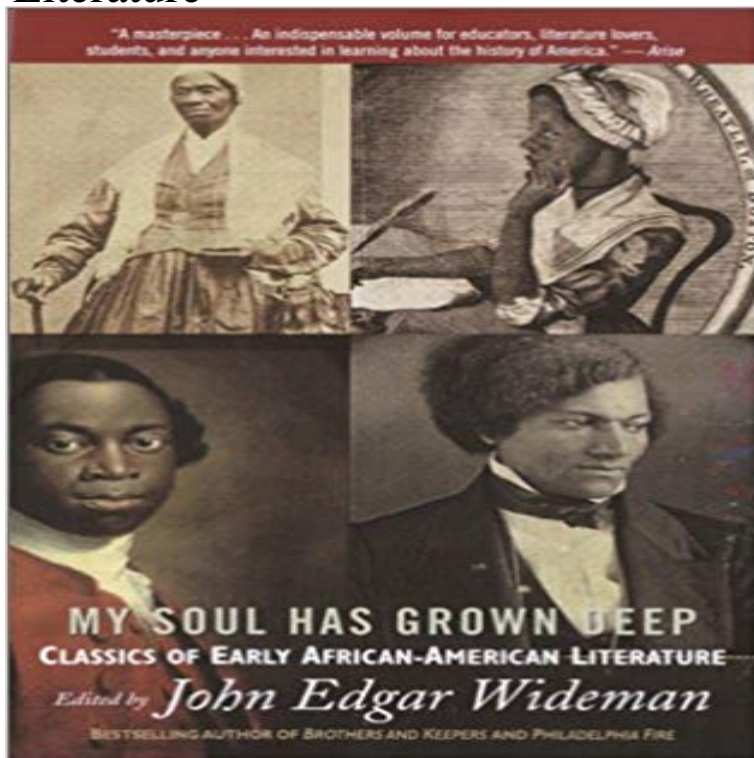


My Soul Has Grown Deep: Classics of Early African-American Literature

Wells's haunting descriptions of lynchings, and the crisp, compelling adventures of Olaudah Equiano. Wideman prefaces each selection with an illuminating biographical essay. The fruit of a lifetime's devotion to the best American writing, *My Soul Has Grown Deep* will stand as an enduring monument to the depth and beauty of African-American literature.
