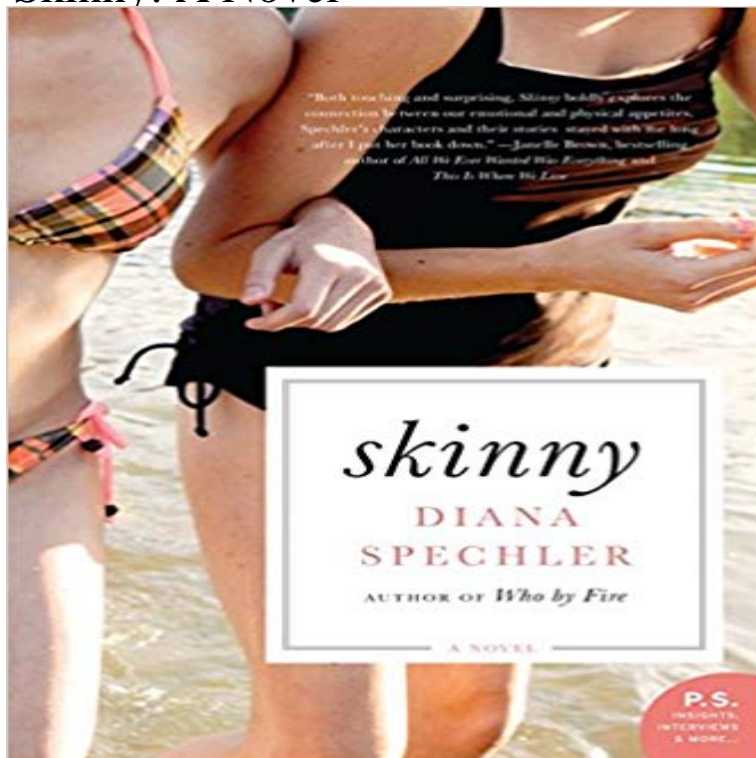


Skinny: A Novel
