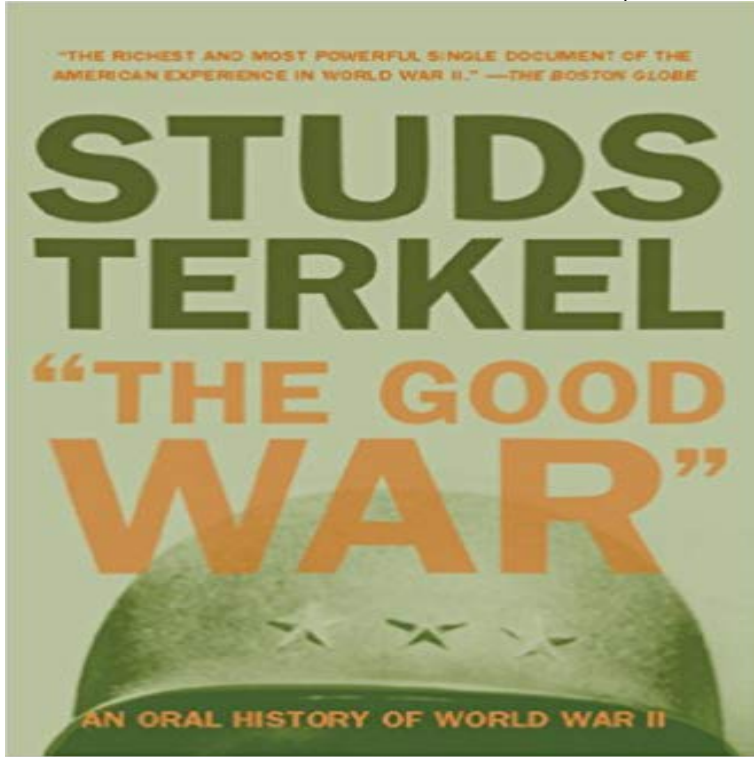


The Good War: An Oral History of World War II
