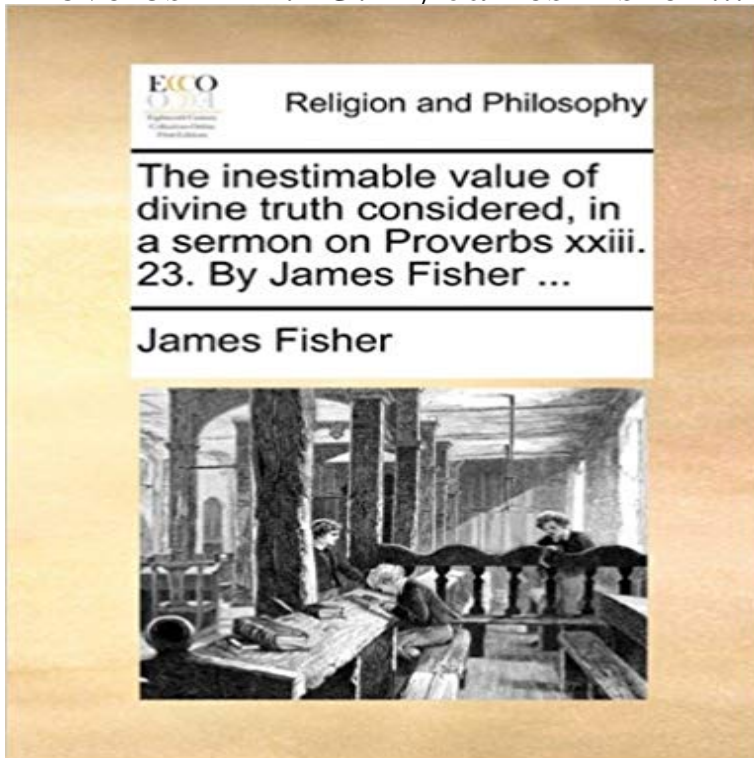


# The inestimable value of divine truth considered, in a sermon on Proverbs xxiii. 23. By James Fisher ...
