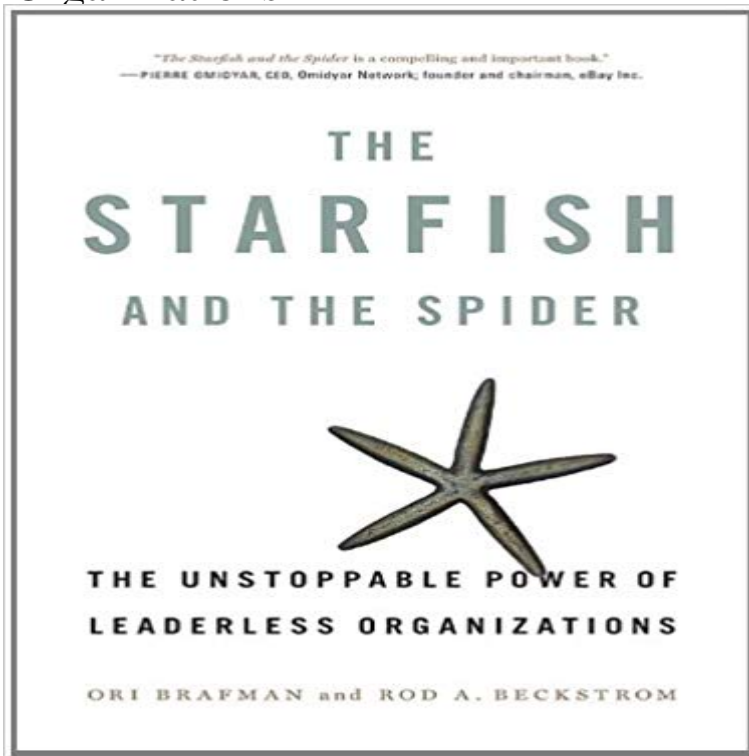


The Starfish and the Spider: The Unstoppable Power of Leaderless Organizations
